The Player:	
	I will always play by the rules.
	I will respect the Umpire / Referee's governance of the game. I will never argue with
	them.
	I will not engage in verbal sledging or physical abuse.
	I will never arrive at the venue intoxicated and will not consume alcohol on The
	Centre grounds.
	I will display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
	I will show respect to all individuals regardless of gender, ability, sexual orientation,
	or cultural background.
Parents play a crucial role in sportsmanship for junior players. Kids learn by copying the	
actions of people around them, especially their parents. It is important to be a good role	
model	to encourage good sportsmanship in your child.
The Parent:	
	I will encourage my child to play within the rules – I will learn the laws of the game.
	I will not pressure my child and will give positive comments to encourage continued
	effort.
	I will not use bad language nor harass players, referees or other spectators.
	I will not consume alcohol at junior matches nor will I show up intoxicated.
	I will applaud good play by my child's team and opposition.
	I will respect all people regardless of gender, ability or cultural background.
